



Window and Door Decals


Easy-on, easy-off decals can be applied to doors and windows to designate entry and exit points.

Yard signs are economical, can be placed nearly anywhere and are easily moved as needed.













Reception and Lobby Areas

 help prevent the transmission of viruses.
- Pleated cotton cloth face coverings protect staff and visitors alike; plain fabric or custom patterns available. Ear savers can be imprinted with your logo or tagline.
- Floor Decals
 Floor decals and arrows are an effective way to promote one-way movement and social distancing.
- Hand Sanitizer Stands
 Hand sanitizer stations encourage frequent
 use by visitors while they are at your facility.




Conference Rooms and Auditoriums

transmission at check-out registers.


2 Disposable and Sanitizable Menus
